ORDINANCE OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA

Serial No. 2022-39

An Ordinance Amending Prohibited Acts within the Boat Harbor Related to Dogs and Other Domestic Animals.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA:

Section 1. Classification. This ordinance is of a general and permanent nature and shall become a part of the City and Borough of Juneau Municipal Code.

Section 2. Amendment of Section. CBJC 85.25.090 Prohibited acts, is amended to read:

85.25.090 Prohibited acts.

It is unlawful for any owner, master, operator or managing agent or other person to commit any of the following acts within the boat harbor:

...

- (7) To allow or permit any dog or other domestic animal to be tethered or restrained to any part of a float or ramp. If a dog or other domestic animal urinates on a float or ramp, the urine must be cleaned up by the application of water in an amount sufficient to eradicate the urine. If a dog or other domestic animal defecates on a float, ramp, or any other area of the harbor including the parking lot, the feces must be cleaned up immediately and disposed of in a proper trash receptacle. All dogs must be leashed in such a manner that a person capable of controlling the dog is able to maintain positive control of them while on the dock, and in compliance with CBJC 08.40.020.

Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance shall be effective 30 days after its adoption.
