# NOTICE OF REGULAR MUNICIPAL ELECTION—OCTOBER 1, 2002

Notice is hereby given that a Regular Municipal Election will be held in the City & Borough of Juneau, Alaska on the **1st day of October, 2002**. The polls will be open from **7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.** on Election Day. Polling places are shown below. Registered voters of the State of Alaska who reside within the City and Borough of Juneau are eligible to vote in this election. Voters should be prepared to display identification at the polling place when voting.

## The purpose of the election is:

1. To elect from candidates residing in the entire City and Borough of Juneau, one Areawide Assemblymember for a term of three years;
2. To elect from candidates residing in Election District No. 1, one Assemblymember for a term of three years;
3. To elect from candidates residing in Election District No. 2, one Assemblymember for a term of three years;
4. To elect from candidates residing in the entire City and Borough of Juneau, two members of the School Board for two terms of three years each; and
5. To vote on the following areawide proposition:

## PROPOSITION NO. 1

General Obligation Bonds - \$15,000,000

For the purpose of paying part of the cost of acquiring, constructing and equipping various harbor, utility and park improvements within the City and Borough approved by the Public Works and Facilities Committee, shall the City and Borough of Juneau, Alaska, issue and sell its general obligation bonds in the principal sum of not to exceed \$15,000,000, maturing within 20 years of date of issue, in accordance with Ordinance Serial No. 2002-30.

Assuming the bonds mature over a 20-year period and bear interest at an average rate of 5.5% per annum, the estimated total cost of the improvements (including estimated total interest on the bonds) is \$25,100,000. **VOTER QUALIFICATIONS**

To be eligible to vote in the City and Borough of Juneau election, you must be:

1. Qualified to vote in state elections;
2. A resident of the municipality for at least 30 days immediately preceding the election;
3. Registered to vote in state elections at a residence address within the municipality at least 30 days before the municipal election at which the person seeks to vote; and
4. Not disqualified under Article V of the State of Alaska Constitution.



## ABSENTEE VOTING FOR THE MUNICIPAL ELECTION

The Clerk's Office has absentee ballot applications available for residents who will be out of town on October 1, 2002, municipal election day, and would like to vote.

Voters seeking to have a ballot mailed to them must complete a written request or absentee ballot application, available from the Clerk's Office or the CBJ web site at:

It is not necessary to complete an absentee ballot application to apply for a ballot. The voter is allowed to request a ballot via written request.

The written request **must** contain the voter's name; a **residence** address in Juneau; the address where the ballot is to be mailed; and, for identification purposes, either the voter's social security number, voter number, or birthdate. The voter **must** also **sign** and **date** the request.

**By Mail:** An Absentee by Mail application or letter of request must be received by the Clerk's Office at the address above no later than Tuesday, September 24, 2002.

**By Fax:** A written request for a fax ballot must be received by the Clerk's Office at the address above no later than 5:00 p.m. on Monday, September 30, 2002, please contact the Clerk's Office to have a fax ballot application sent to you. Fax voting requires the voter to agree to the following statement: "I understand that by using fax transmission to return my marked ballot, I am voluntarily waiving a portion of my right to a secret ballot to the extent necessary to process my ballot, but expect that my vote will be held as confidential as possible."

### In-Person Absentee Voting:

Municipal Building (City Hall) In-Person Absentee Voting will be available between 8:00am-4:30pm, Monday - Friday, beginning Monday, September 16, 2002 through Monday, September 30, 2002 as well as Saturday, September 28 from 10am-5pm. Room locations will change during this time so please follow the signs.

Mendenhall Mall (Middle Entrance by Bullwinkles) In-Person Absentee Voting will be available Monday - Friday, beginning Monday, September 16, 2002 through Monday, September 30, 2002 as well as Saturday, September 28 - times to be announced.

### Personal Representative Voting:

Persons who are ill or unable to go to the polls, who still wish to vote and have not chosen one of the above methods, should contact the Clerk's Office to make arrangements for an absentee ballot by personal representative.
