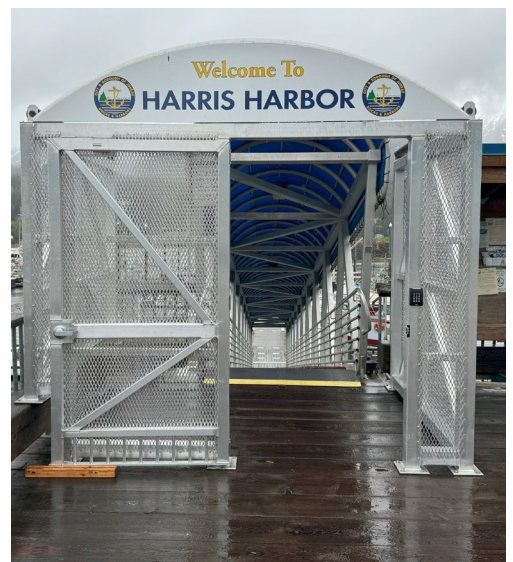

Port Director's Corner: On June 3rd, Docks & Harbors accepted substantial completion from Trucano Construction for the rebuilding of Aurora Harbor "H Float". This \$4.25M project known as Aurora Harbor Phase III was funded with CBJ Harbor Enterprise funds, 2017 CBJ 1% Sales Tax Initiative funds and \$2M from the ADOT Harbor Facility Grant. Phase III provides slips for 60-foot/48-foot vessels and 280 linear feet of transient moorage. This phase also provides electrical service, potable and firefighting water for H Float. Aurora Harbor Phase IV will complete the rebuilding of the harbor with the installation of two additional main floats (I & J Floats). Additionally, Phase IV will augment the transient moorage at H Float with 42-foot slips and with a 117-foot T-float. These structural amenities were not awarded in Phase III due to financial constraints. To celebrate the successful completion of Aurora Phase III, there will be a ribbon cutting ceremony on Monday, June 24th at 3 pm. The Juneau community is cordially invited to attend the ceremony followed by **Docks & Harbors annual Customer Appreciation cookout**. Lieutenant Governor Dahlstrom will be guest speaker during the ceremony. Please come out and to celebrate and to enjoy a hot dog or burger with your Docks & Harbors staff & Board members.



Harris Harbor Security Gate: As many of you have noticed, the new security gate in Harris Harbor has been installed and looks great. We are still awaiting a few materials to complete the installation of new overhead lights at the approach dock and other security enhancements. We are hopeful that the gate will be operational by July 1, 2024. The gate will be open to the public daily from 0500 to 2300. For access outside of those hours, a key FOB will be required. Stall holders are eligible to receive up to two FOBs free of charge. If you already have a FOB for the cranes or restrooms, it can be programmed for the gate as well. Transient boaters will need to purchase a FOB at a cost of \$10.50 each. Please plan to visit the Aurora office in the coming weeks to have your FOB programmed or to purchase/pick up new FOBs.

New Harbors Fees: July 1st marks the start of the new CBJ Fiscal Year (FY). Each FY results in a fee adjustment tied to the Urban Alaska CPI. The 2023 CPI was 1.5% and patrons will see this increase in future bills. Our rates are provided [here](#).

New CBJ-wide Parking System: Docks and Harbors is excited to announce the modernization and standardization of our paid parking system in partnership with CBJ. All paid parking within CBJ (with the exception of Juneau Airport) will be managed through a unified system. Customers can now conveniently pay via phone using the IPS Park Smarter App. Additionally, payment and citation contests can be handled directly through the app. Self-service kiosks will still be available for those who prefer them, with existing kiosks being replaced by new units from IPS. Enforcement of paid parking will now rely on license plate numbers, eliminating the need for physical receipts on the dashboard. The new system is effective at Taku Lot downtown (Twisted Fish). Stand-up of Statter Parking using the new system is anticipated to be operational soon. Access/download the Park Smarter App by scanning the QR code.
