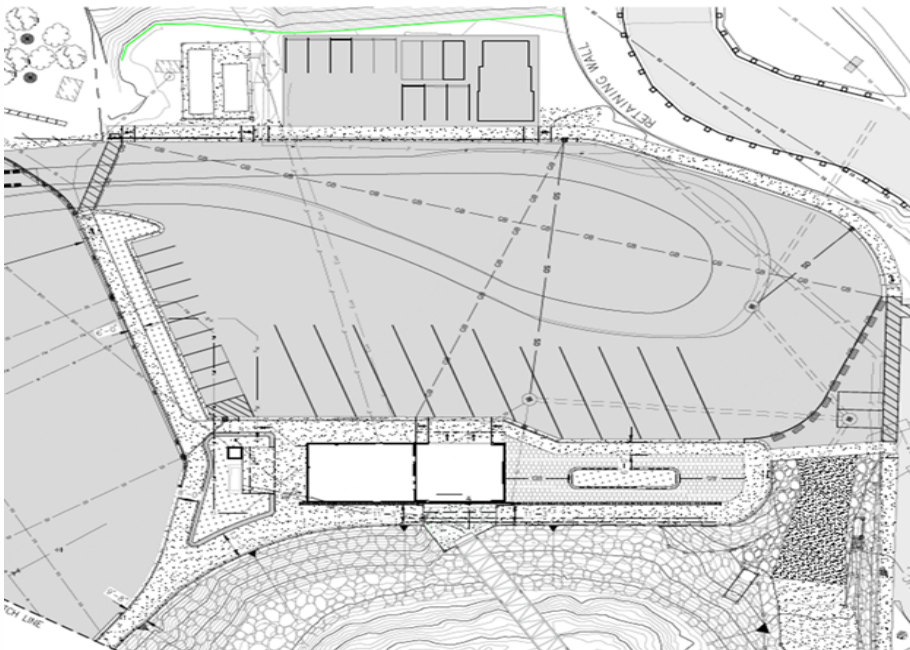
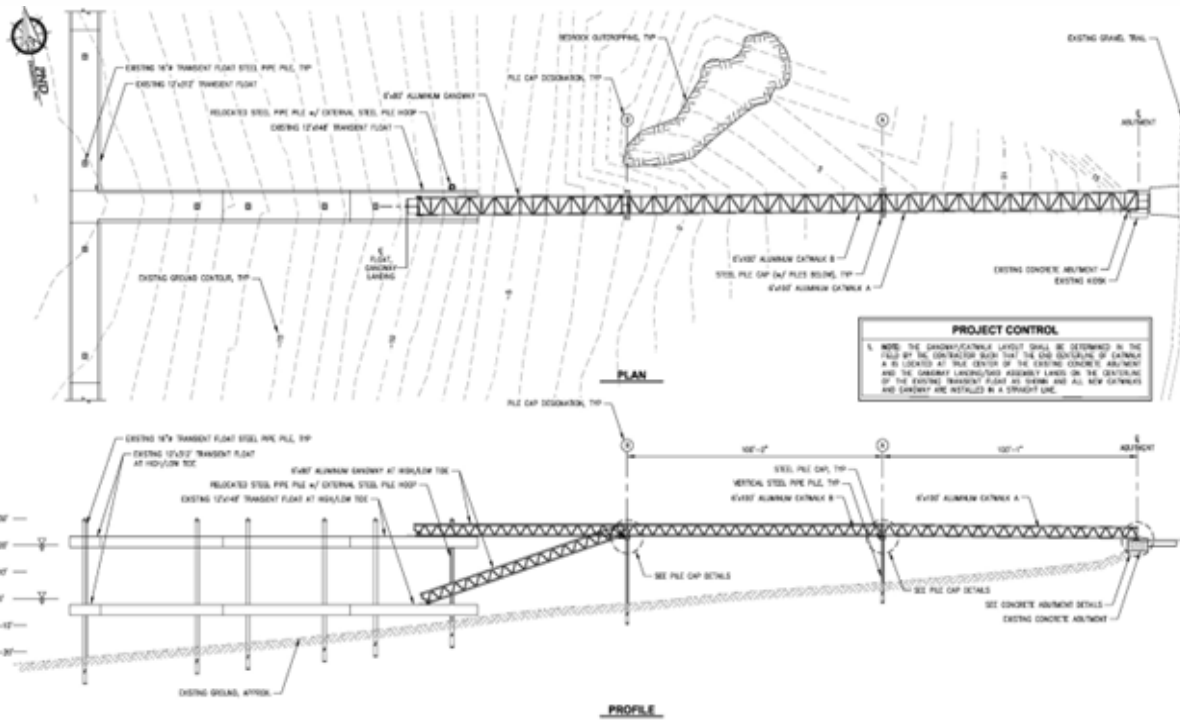
Aurora Phase IV Project Update: The bids to construct the final phase of Aurora Harbor Rebuild were opened on March 25th. The results are:

The Assembly approved the bid award to Western Marine Construction on April 7th. The Alternate bid item was accepted, and it will provide corrosion protection to each piling with the installation of zinc anodes. Upon contractual agreement, Western Marine Construction will have until April 1st 2026 to complete the work.

Taku Harbor Approach Dock Repairs:

Docks & Harbors has entered into a cooperative agreement with Alaska Department of Fish and Game (ADFG) to replace the deteriorating approach floats at Taku Harbor. The estimated project cost is \$1.6M with our local match being 25%. We anticipate bids to be advertised in late April or May. The project will replace the in-water floats with an elevated aluminum walk-way.



Statter Harbor Phase IIID: This project will finish the Statter Phase III improvements by providing curb, gutter and paving to the uplands parking lot which serves the tourism bus parking lot. We anticipate having the \$3M project awarded in May 2025 with final completion in May 2026. In addition to the parking lot paving, we will install aesthetically pleasing sidewalk with a plaza and plantings.
