



2026 SENIOR CITIZEN PROOF OF AGE AND RESIDENCY

(This form is not required if all applicants have a valid CBJ Senior Exemption Card)

To qualify for the Hardship Sales Tax Rebate, applicants must:

- Seniors and Spouses must be 65 years of age or older, and
- Have maintained a principal place of abode within the State of Alaska and the City and Borough of Juneau for at least thirty (30) consecutive days immediately preceding this application, with the intent to remain indefinitely.

Documentation Requirements

A copy of the following documentation must be presented at the time of application.

Proof of Residency: One of the following is acceptable for proof of residency:

- ♦ Valid CBJ Senior Sales Tax Exemption Card
- ♦ Alaska Driver’s License or State ID
- ♦ Juneau Voter Registration Card
- ♦ Juneau Utility Bill in your name
- ♦ Alaska Hunting/Fishing License
- ♦ Airline or Ferry Ticket showing date of arrival in Juneau

Proof of Age: One of the following is acceptable for proof of age:

- ♦ Alaska Driver’s License or State ID
- ♦ Birth Certificate
- ♦ Passport
- ♦ Medicare Card
- ♦ Valid CBJ Senior Sales Tax Exemption Card
(a spouse card does not qualify as proof of age)
