## DEPARTMENT OF THE ARMY PERMIT MODIFICATION

Department of the Army permit number POA-1996-19-M, was issued to the City and Borough of Juneau (CBJ) on October 16, 2006, authorizing the CBJ to "place 33,900 cubic yards of clean gravelly sand into 5.95 acres of forested wetlands associated with the construction of house pads, driveways, and domestic wastewater treatment drain-fields."

This is the 3rd modification of the original permit. The permit is hereby modified as follows:

The project site is located within Section 24, T. 40 S., R. 64 E. and Section 19, T. 40 S., R. 65 E., Copper River Meridian; USGS Quad Map Juneau B-3; Latitude 58.385° N., Longitude 134.761° W.; South Lena Subdivision; Point Lena, in Juneau, Alaska.

In accordance with your request, General Condition No. 1 of the permit is hereby amended to read as follows:

The time limit for completing the work authorized ends on <u>October 31, 2021</u>. If you find that you need more time to complete the authorized activity, please submit your request for a time extension to the Corps of Engineers for consideration at least one month before permit expiration.

All other conditions under which the subject authorization was made remain in full force and effect.

This authorization should be attached to the original permit. Also enclosed is a Notice of Authorization that should be posted in a prominent location near the authorized work.
