## **Terminal Renovation.**

The Departure Lounge ceiling and lighting improvements are complete. Furniture is expected to arrive in June and design of new signage will be ready soon. Miscellaneous amenities such as the laptop counter and display cases will continue to be installed through the summer. We look forward to greeting our seasonal visitors with a fresh, contemporary look in the renovated Departure Lounge.

Construction began in the Check-In Lobby at the end of March. The project will result in a new 2-step system, new interior finishes, and energy efficient lighting. The temporary check-in system is working fine, but we are all looking forward to completing this work before passenger loads increase.

Following the Airport Board work session on March 19<sup>th</sup>, I met with architect Tony Yorba to begin developing design options for the remaining exterior portion of the 1984 building face. We expect to have documents ready for construction in a few weeks. This will allow the siding, windows, and doors to be installed by late summer.
