General

In the past month construction has continued on two major projects.

RSA Expansion Phase IIA

The project is within a few days of the schedule provided by the general contractor in August 2012.

Significant accomplishments in the last month include:

- Completion of paving on the runway at the new east end.
- Paving at the north float pond road.
- Placement of Recycled Asphalt Pavement (RAP) on the south float pond road.
- Installation of electrical conduit and wiring along Taxiway A
- Installation of the pilings and platform for the Runway 26 MALS shelter.

Some photos of the work in progress are included on the next page.

Anticipated work in May includes:

- Completion of paving on the extended portion of Taxiway A and the new Taxiway G
- Shift of the Runway 8 threshold to Station 8+80
- Begin work on the new Runway 8 approach lighting system
- Begin work on reconfiguration of Taxiway B

We are holding weekly construction meetings at 9:30 Tuesday mornings in the Juneau Room.

Yandukin/Shell Simmons Pavement Rehabilitation

The project is behind schedule by a few days due to weather delays.

Significant accomplishments in the last month include:

- Installation of construction signage.
- Excavation for sidewalk improvements including temporary ramps to access the terminal and pedestrian detour signs.
