Actions:

Presentations:

- 1) ICLEI, Amy Shatzklin—Senior Program Officer
 - a. Slide show handout passed out
 - b. Excellent overview of their program
 - c. Cities develop their own sustainability office
 - d. They have emission analysis software
 - e. New Hampshire action plan finished on the adaptation section of the web site. Software can be used for constructing scenarios.
 - f. The Climate Registry is an organization. States report their emissions. The goal is to reduce emission 7% below 1990 levels.
 - g. Environment, equity, economy are goals to improve community livability
 - h. Green Building Council evolving from the community sustainability program of ICLEI.
 - i. Commutative local actions with a focus on mitigation and adaptation. Mitigation saves the community \$ while adaptation prepares the community for change and makes them more resilient.

2) Parking Garage, Rorie Watt—city engineer. Good discussion about the project including 11 million funding available, goal to improve operations for transit staff (break room). Library parking does not serve downtown. Fee ordinance allowing businesses to pay into a fund instead of providing on-site parking. Build oversize columns for future floors. Juneau doubled population size since 1970 but not in downtown. The building footprint is not open for discussion.
