Summary:

On 01-04-07 at about 1854 hours, the Juneau Police Department received a report of a collision between a pedestrian and a motor vehicle near the 6500 block of Glacier Hwy. On arrival, officers contacted a 13 year old juvenile who sustained minor injuries. Investigation revealed a 1998 Dodge pickup driven by a 23 year old Juneau man was traveling outbound on Glacier Hwy when the pedestrian ran across the highway. The truck tried to avoid the pedestrian, however, the pedestrian ran into the drivers door of the truck. The truck sustained no damage. The pedestrian was taken by ambulance to BRH for evaluation.

Investigation continues.

Any charges reported in this press release are merely accusations and the defendants are presumed innocent unless and until proven guilty.
