**Subject: Burglary 1<sup>st</sup> Degree**

### Summary:

On 01/31/2007, at approximately 2:08 pm, the Juneau Police Department received a report of a possible residential burglary on Tee Way. In essence, the home owner reported that they returned home to discover a ladder propped up against the bathroom window. In addition, there was a strange vehicle parked in a nearby parking lot. The home owner entered the residence and heard a commotion near the back of the house. The strange vehicle then left the area.

At approximately 2:50 pm, the same vehicle was located at another residence near 19.5 mile Glacier Highway. Department of Motor Vehicles records indicated that the vehicle was parked at its owner's residence.

At the residence officers contacted Brendan DOYLE, an 18 year old Juneau male. Officers obtained a search warrant and recovered property that had been stolen from the Tee Way house. The vehicle DOYLE had been driving was also seized. DOYLE was left at the residence.

On 02/02/2007, the District Attorney obtained an arrest warrant for DOYLE with \$10,000 bail for Burglary in the First Degree.

On 02/03/2007, at approximately 7:29 pm, DOYLE was contacted and arrested on the outstanding arrest warrant.

Since 01/01/2007, the Juneau Police Department has investigated 16 other burglaries in the Juneau area. The investigation continues into the similarities of these burglaries.

Any charges reported in this press release are merely accusations and the defendants are presumed innocent unless and until proven guilty.
