## INFORMATION RELEASE

**Subject: Roll Over Motor Vehicle Accident**

**Date: March 6, 2007**

### Summary:

On March 6, 2007 at approximately 1700 hours, the Juneau Police Department received a telephone call from a 38-year-old male Juneau resident reporting a roll over accident Egan Drive outbound at the Retaining Wall. The 38-year-old male said he was the solitary occupant and driver of the vehicle. The man further said he was not injured.

Juneau Police Officers responded to the scene and found a 1990 blue and white Ford Bronco on its roof top partially blocking both lanes of traffic. Investigation revealed the vehicle was traveling outbound on Egan Drive when the driver looked down to grab something he was pulled into the snow berm along the retaining wall. The vehicle continued into the berm raising the passenger side and ultimately rolling the vehicle onto its side and coming to rest on its top. Excessive speed was not a factor in the accident. The driver was issued a citation for Careless Driving and the vehicle was towed from the scene.

Outbound evening traffic was affected as a single lane of travel was the only means of travel from downtown Juneau to the Valley and Lemon Creek areas.
