Subject: Disorderly Conduct

Summary:

On 03-23-07 at about 0852 hours, the Juneau Police Dept. responded to the 3000 block of Douglas Hwy for a report of man that was purposely walking in front of vehicles in transit on the roadway.

On arrival, officers contacted 34 year old David Young of Juneau. As officers attempted to take Young into custody for his reported actions, he became uncooperative and attempted to flee the area on foot. After a short foot pursuit, Young was taken into custody. The contact with Young caused the north bound traffic lane to be shut down and traffic impeded for a short time.

Young was ultimately lodged at the Lemon Creek Correctional Center for the charges of Disorderly Conduct, Resisting/Interfering with an Officer and Violating Conditions of Release, all misdemeanor offenses.

Any charges reported in this press release are merely accusations and the defendants are presumed innocent unless and until proven guilty.
