Subject: Assault 1st degree **Date:** May 27th, 2007

Summary:

On Sunday, May 27th, 2007 at about 1826 hours, the Juneau Police Department received a call from the Thane Road campground requesting medical assistance for a man who had just been cut with a knife under his chin.

Upon arrival, officers contacted a 45 year old local man, who identified another resident at the camp site for assaulting him. Officers were able to follow a blood trail to a camp site and located another victim, a 37 year old local female resident, who had a laceration to her left hand. Also, sitting in front of this camp site was the suspect, identified as 46 year old local resident, Eric MORROW.

MORROW was subsequently arrested for Assault 1st degree, Assault domestic violence 3rd degree and Resisting Arrest. The charge of Assault 1st degree is punishable by up to 30 years in jail and \$500,000 fine. The charge of Assault domestic violence 3rd degree, is punishable by up to 5 years in jail and \$50,000 fine. Resisting Arrest is punishable by up to 1 year in jail, and \$10,000 fine.

MORROW was transported to and lodged at Lemon Creek Correctional Center with no bail.

Both victims were transported by Capital City Fire and Rescue Personnel to Bartlett Regional Hospital for treatment and were then released.

Any charges reported in this press release are merely accusations and the defendants are presumed innocent unless and until proven guilty.
