Subject: Motor Vehicle Crash

Summary:

This morning at approximately 7:30am the Juneau Police Department received a report of a rollover accident at the 2900 block of Douglas Highway. Witnesses reported that a gray 2003 Dodge pickup was traveling on Douglas Highway towards the bridge when it struck a white 2000 Ford Ranger that was parked on the side of the highway. The front passenger side of the Dodge impacted the rear driver's side of the Ford. The Dodge flipped over coming to rest on its roof. The parked pickup was unoccupied.

The driver and only occupant of the Dodge was a 22 year old Juneau resident. Capital City Fire and Rescue personnel responded and extricated him from the pickup and transported him to Bartlett Regional Hospital with non-life threatening injuries.

Both vehicles were totaled and patrol officers continue to investigate the incident.

Any charges reported in this press release are merely accusations and the defendants are presumed innocent unless and until proven guilty.
