## INFORMATION RELEASE

**Subject: MVA Injury**

### Summary:

**On Tuesday, July 6, 2010, at 11:38 AM, the officers from the Juneau Police Department and personnel from Capital City Fire Rescue responded to a two vehicle accident on Egan Dr by Yandukin Dr. Both vehicles were in the left-turn lane to go towards Fred Meyer.**

**Investigation revealed that the driver, a 74 year old Juneau resident, of a 1995 Subaru Legacy was going too fast for road conditions to stop. The Subaru struck the rear bumper of a stationary 2001 Chevy Silverado. Both drivers were uninjured while a passenger in the Silverado was transported via ambulance to Bartlett Regional Hospital to be evaluated for non-life threatening injuries. The Subaru was totaled while the Chevy sustained around \$4,000 worth of damage.**

**The driver of the Subaru was cited Basic Speed.**

**The traffic on the turn lane towards Fred Meyer on Egan Drive was closed for about an hour while the vehicles were removed.**

**Any charges reported in this press release are merely accusations and the defendants are presumed innocent unless and until proven guilty.**
