**Subject: Attempt to Serve**

### Summary:

This afternoon at approximately 3:30 p.m., the Juneau police Department contacted a 49 year old Juneau man to serve court paperwork. When police contacted the man at his residence, he refused to come out. Officers secured the area and began talking to the man through the residence door. The man's wife is also in the residence. It is unknown at this time if she is being kept there against her will.

The incident is on going. Updates will be provided as developments warrant.

### Update:

The woman came out of the residence around 8:55 p.m. last night and was safely moved to an alternate location. Some neighboring residents were relocated at their own request. The incident is ongoing updates will be provided as they are available.

### Update:

Police remained at the residence throughout the night continuing to talk to him. The man verbally responded to officers throughout the night. The man had axes, swords, and a pitch fork in his possession. Several times he raised them in the residence window so that officers were able to see them.

At approximately 12:00pm the man willingly came out of the residence and police took him to Bartlett Regional Hospital. Once he was safe and out of the building, other building residents were notified and many of them came back to their apartments.

JPD would like to thank JAHMI, CCF/R, Gastineau Humane Society, and the other City departments who supported the officers and that ultimately resulted in the successful outcome of this event.
