Summary:

On Aug.24<sup>th</sup>, 2010 at about 11:16 PM, the Juneau Police Department received a 911 call reporting a female had been struck by a vehicle in the Coho Apartments parking lot. The caller said the vehicle that struck the female left the scene.

Officers arrived on scene and contacted the 19 year old female victim. She told Officers she had a confrontation with persons known to her that were inside the vehicle that struck her. She reported the driver of the vehicle struck her with the car and knocked her to the ground and left the area.

Capital City Fire Rescue responded to the scene to evaluate the victim. The victim sustained non life threatening injuries and declined medical transport to Bartlett Regional Hospital.

Officers contacted the driver and occupants of the suspect vehicle a short distance away from the scene. They were interviewed and ultimately released from the scene.

This case is actively being investigated. Possible charges may be forthcoming against the driver of the vehicle.

Any charges reported in this press release are merely accusations and the defendants are presumed innocent unless and until proven guilty.
