Summary:

On Saturday, 09-16-06, JPD received a report of a pedestrian that was struck by a car at the 8700 block of Glacier Hwy. Subsequent investigation revealed a 2006 Jeep carry-all was driving at low speed and struck a 72 year old Juneau man. The Jeep sustained minor damage. The pedestrian was taken by ambulance to Bartlett Regional Hospital for treatment of minor injuries.

UPDATE

Date: Monday, September 18, 2006

Summary:

The Juneau Police Department was informed by Bartlett Regional Hospital Staff that the 72-year old male's injuries were determined to be more severe than previously thought. The male was first medically stabilized by BRH ER personnel then medevac'd via medical flight to the Alaska Native Regional Medical Center in Anchorage.
