## INFORMATION RELEASE

**Subject: Assault 1<sup>st</sup> Degree**

**Date: 09/20/2007**

### Summary:

On 09/19/2007, at approximately 9:32 pm, the Juneau Police Department received a report of a stabbing at an apartment located in the 9300 block of the Glacier Highway. In essence, a female witness said that her boyfriend had been stabbed in the chest and leg by an unknown female suspect.

The investigation revealed that Annie SMALLWOOD, a 25 year old Juneau resident, entered the apartment and confronted the male victim about a domestic issue with his girlfriend. SMALLWOOD and the male victim do not have a current or past domestic relationship.

SMALLWOOD produced a knife and the male fell over as he was backing away. SMALLWOOD stabbed the male victim once in the upper right chest and once in the right thigh. SMALLWOOD then left the apartment.

SMALLWOOD was contacted as she exited a neighboring apartment. Inside the neighboring apartment a bloody knife was found and seized as evidence. SMALLWOOD was taken to the Juneau Police Department. She was subsequently arrested for Assault in the 1<sup>st</sup> Degree, a class A felony, then transported to the Lemon Creek Correctional Center and lodged on no bail.

The male victim was transported to the Bartlett Regional Hospital for treatment of his injuries, which included a collapsed lung. The male victim is expected to recover from the injuries.

Alcohol was involved with both SMALLWOOD and the male victim.

Investigation continues.

Any charges reported in this press release are merely accusations and the defendants are presumed innocent unless and until proven guilty.
