## INFORMATION RELEASE

**Subject: Theft 2<sup>nd</sup> Degree**

### Summary:

On 09/23/2007, at approximately 1236 hours, the Juneau Police Department received a report of a theft that occurred to a business located in the 2500 block of Industrial Blvd. In essence, the business owner said that multiple items were stolen from his business, and an adjoining business.

Video surveillance indicated that one male suspect came to the business on 09/22/2007 in the evening. The suspect was later identified as Jerry Nelson, a 45 year old Juneau resident. Nelson was later joined at the business by a second male. Together Nelson and the second male take multiple items from the business property. The stolen items included a crab pot cooker, hydraulic press and tank, two vintage vehicle radiators, an aluminum sink, and some wire. The total value of the stolen property was estimated at approximately \$2,415.00.

On 09/24/2007, at approximately 1430 hours, Juneau Police Officers served a search warrant at Nelson's residence located in the 1600 block of Fritz Cove Road. Some of the stolen items were located at the residence.

Nelson was contacted inside the residence and taken to JPD. Nelson was subsequently placed under arrest for Theft in the 2<sup>nd</sup> Degree, a class C Felony. Nelson was transported to the Lemon Creek Correctional Center and lodged on no bail.

Investigation continues.

Any charges reported in this press release are merely accusations and the defendants are presumed innocent unless and until proven guilty.
