Summary:

On 09-26-07 at about 2303 hours, the Juneau Police Department responded to James Blvd near Mendenhall Loop Road for a collision between a bicyclist and a motor vehicle.

Subsequent investigation determined a 53 year old Juneau man was riding his bicycle on the bike path north bound approaching James Blvd. A 1975 Chevy truck, driven by an 18 year old Juneau man had negotiated a left hand turn onto James Blvd from Mendenhall Loop Road. The bicyclist collided with the side of the truck.

The truck sustained about \$400 damage and the bicyclist was transported to Bartlett Regional Hospital by a police officer where the cyclist was treated and released for minor injuries. No citations have been issued at this time.

Any charges reported in this press release are merely accusations and the defendants are presumed innocent unless and until proven guilty.
