Summary:

On Wednesday October 28, 2009 at approximately 5:15 PM, the Juneau Police Department received a third hand report about an alleged threat against a Yakoos student.

Officers contacted the complainant and the potential victim in the threat. After investigating the officers were unable to substantiate the threat. School administrators for both Yakoos and JDHS were notified.

Today school classes are on their normal schedules. The School District has put additional security measures in place today. The Juneau Police Department School Resource Officers are also at the schools and working with staff.

UPDATE: 10/29/09 11:50 AM

School Resource Officers and School Administrators coordinated and were able to determine the origin of the alleged threat. After talking with students involved it was determined no threat was made and no weapons were located. At this time there are no students being charged as there was no actual threat. School operations have resumed as normal.

The School District and the Juneau Police Department would like to thank those students who came forward with information. Please remember if you have any information about threats at school to report them immediately to school staff or the police.
