## INFORMATION RELEASE

**Subject: Misconduct Controlled Substances 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup>**

### Summary:

On 10/06/2007, at approximately 6:23 pm, members of the South East Alaska Narcotics Enforcement Team (SEANET) conducted a traffic stop on a vehicle at the Fred Meyer gas station. The vehicle was stopped pursuant to a federal search warrant.

The passenger of the vehicle was identified as 19 year old Juneau resident Tyrone BEVERLY. BEVERLY was transported to the Juneau Police Department and subsequently placed under arrest for a probation violation and Misconduct Involving a Controlled Substance in the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> Degree, a class A and class B felony respectively. BEVERLY was lodged at the Lemon Creek Correctional Center on No Bail.

The driver of the vehicle was a 19 year old Juneau female resident. The female was transported to the Juneau Police Department and then released. The vehicle was seized as evidence.

The investigation revealed that BEVERLY received a package through the United State Postal Service. The package had been intercepted and was discovered to contain 9.9 gross grams of heroin. The estimated street value is approximately \$4,000.00.

Agencies contributing to this SEANET operation included members of the Juneau Police Department, Sitka Police Department, Petersburg Police Department, and the United States Postal Service.

The investigation is continuing.

Any charges reported in this press release are merely accusations and the defendants are presumed innocent unless and until proven guilty.
