Summary:

On 10-08-2007, at 4:22pm, the Juneau Police Department received a report of a one vehicle injury accident at 33 mile Glacier Highway.

A 2005 Dodge Neon driven by 23 year old Patrick Honey of Washington State was northbound on Glacier Highway when he lost control of the vehicle, left the roadway and struck a tree. The car then bounced back into the road coming to a stop in the southbound lane. There were several witnesses to the accident who said speed appeared to be a factor and there were open alcohol containers in the car.

Transported to Bartlett Regional Hospital by Capital City Fire Rescue were Honey and his passengers 28 year old Juneau resident Nichole Benedict, along with her two small children ages 2 and 3. None of their injuries appear to be life threatening.

No citations have been issued, and no criminal charges have been filed at this time, however the investigation is continuing.

Any charges reported in this press release are merely accusations and the defendants are presumed innocent unless and until proven guilty.
