Summary:

On 11-27-09 at about 1742 hours, JPD received a report from the Johnson Youth Center that two juvenile inmates had scaled a fence and fled the Detention Center on foot. During a search of the area, they could not be located. The Juneau Police Department is seeking assistance from the public in locating the subjects. They are identified as:

Robert Lee, 17 year old native male about 6'3", 160 pounds, brown hair and brown eyes.

Tyler Allen, 16 year old native male about 6'2", 150 pounds, brown hair and brown eyes.

Lee was last seen wearing a black hoodie sweat shirt and blue jeans. Allen was last seen wearing navy colored pants and a green polo shirt. If anyone knows the whereabouts of these subjects, please call the Juneau Police Department at 586-0600.
