## INFORMATION RELEASE

**Subject: Assault 3<sup>rd</sup> Degree**

### Summary:

On 12-30-2009, at approximately 11:39 pm, the Juneau Police Department received a report of a disturbance coming from a residence located in the Gruening Park Apartments. The report stated they heard shouting and a gun shot.

Juneau Police officers arrived on scene and entered the apartment, which was empty. Outside the apartment building officers located a 38 year old Juneau male resident who is known to live inside the apartment where the disturbance took place.

The investigation revealed that the 38 year old male victim was at his apartment with several other people. One of the victim's roommates, 39 year old Juneau male resident Thomas LEIGH-KENDALL, arrived home and became upset because his television was missing. LEIGH-KENDALL pulled out a handgun and fired one bullet into the 38 year old victim's stereo. The occupants of the apartment fled and no one was injured by the gun shot.

The Juneau Police Department is asking for assistance in locating Thomas LIEGH-KENDALL. LEIGH-KENDALL is a convicted felon and is considered armed and dangerous. Citizens are encouraged to contact the Juneau Police Department or Crime Line immediately if they have any information concerning LIEGH-KENDALL's whereabouts.

The investigation continues.

**Any charges reported in this press release are merely accusations and the defendants are presumed innocent unless and until proven guilty.**
