Subject: Stabbing

Case or Incident Summary: 2007-037682

On 10-29-2007, approximately 9:09am, Capital Transit requested an ambulance and police respond to Main Street bus stop for some type of medical emergency.

Upon arrival, officers discovered the situation was not a medical call but that a 67 year old Juneau man had been stabbed.

Investigation revealed the victim had been in a verbal dispute with the suspect earlier at a downtown restaurant. The victim left the restaurant and walked over to the bus stop when the suspect approached him again and an argument ensued.

The suspect, identified as 18 year old Charles Reynolds, allegedly pulled a knife and stabbed the victim three times in the head. The victim was transported to Bartlett Regional Hospital by ambulance for treatment of his injuries. Those injuries are not believed to be life threatening.

Reynolds was arrested and charged with Assault in the 2nd degree a Class B Felony. He was lodged at Lemon Creek Correctional Center without bail.

Any charges reported in this press release are merely accusations and the defendants are presumed innocent unless and until proven guilty.
