Summary:

Earlier this year the City and Borough of Juneau installed a new E-9-1-1 switch to begin the process of improved services to the citizens of Juneau. In an effort to move to the next phase of E-9-1-1 compliance, the City has begun gathering mapping information including verifying streets, addresses, and fire hydrant locations. When we have completed this project the information will be used by E-9-1-1 emergency personnel to be able to locate on a map a caller who is using landline phone service.

Please be aware that there will be City employees gathering this information. Their vehicles will be marked with a sign that has the City Logo and says "Mapping and Data Collection". Staff will be working between the hours of 8:00am and 6:00pm seven (7) days a week. The project will take approximately four (4) months to complete.

Any charges reported in this press release are merely accusations and the defendants are presumed innocent unless and until proven guilty.
