Subject: Attempted Robbery/Assault

Summary:

On 12-04-07 at about 11:55 p.m., the Juneau Police Department received a report from a downtown hotel that the clerk had been assaulted in an attempted robbery.

Officers responded and interviewed the clerk. Investigation revealed the night clerk had been confronted by a male in the lobby who demanded cash and then struck the clerk with a blunt object. No money was taken. The clerk sustained minor injuries. Capital City Fire Rescue responded and transported the clerk to Bartlett Regional Hospital for treatment of injuries.

The assailant fled from the lobby. During a search of the area, the subject could not be located. The subject is described as a white male in his 20's, about six foot, slender build, dark hair shaved close, wearing a white sweatshirt with black markings and dark jeans.

This case remains under investigation. Anyone with information is asked to call the Juneau Police Department at 586-0600 or crime line at 586-4243.

Any charges reported in this press release are merely accusations and the defendants are presumed innocent unless and until proven guilty.
