## INFORMATION RELEASE

**Subject: Injury Accident /26 mile Glacier Hwy      Date: 12-09-2007**

### Summary:

**On 12-09-2007 at 2:35pm the Juneau Police Department received a report of a two vehicle injury accident on Glacier Highway at 26 mile.**

**Investigation revealed a 1997 Ford F-350 pickup driven by 41 year old Juneau resident Douglas Ward was outbound on Glacier Highway, while a 2003 Ford Ranger pickup, driven by 41 year old Leslie Antolick, also of Juneau, was inbound.**

**As the F350 rounded a curve, the driver lost control on the icy roadway and turned broadside to the smaller Ranger pickup and both vehicles collided.**

**CCF/R personnel responded with a total of 4 ambulances. The “Jaws of Life” was used to extricate a juvenile passenger that was trapped in the F-350.**

**The driver and a passenger from the Ford Ranger, and two passengers from the F-350 were transported to Bartlett Regional Hospital for a medical evaluation, the driver of the F350 was not transported.**

**Investigation continues.**

**Any charges reported in this press release are merely accusations and the defendants are presumed innocent unless and until proven guilty.**
