## **Documentary Filmmakers Coming to Juneau**

### ***South Franklin to be closed intermittently next Saturday morning***

On Saturday, March 22, intermittently from 9:00 a.m. to 10:00 a.m., portions of downtown Juneau will be closed to cars and pedestrians to enable filmmakers to shoot portions of a documentary.

South Franklin Street between Ferry Way (Lucky Lady bar) and Front Street (the clock) will be closed intermittently throughout the hour. JPD officers will be stationed on Ferry Way and Marine Way, South Franklin at the traffic circle, and Ferry Way and South Franklin, to redirect traffic. Officers will be in contact with the filmmakers and will allow cars and pedestrians through when possible.
