Summary:

On 02-01-08 at about 3:08 p.m., Capital City Fire Rescue and the Juneau Police responded to Glacier Hwy and Lena Pt. for an injury collision involving a motor vehicle and a four-wheeler all-terrain-vehicle.

Investigation revealed a 58 year old Juneau man was plowing snow across Glacier Hwy from his driveway on his ATV. While pushing snow into a berm, the operator turned the ATV back to cross Glacier Hwy without looking for oncoming traffic. A 1995 Toyota 4-Runner was Glacier Hwy inbound and collided with the ATV causing the ATV driver to be ejected. He was transported to Bartlett Regional Hospital for evaluation of his injuries. He was conscious and alert at Bartlett Regional Hospital .

The Toyota sustained about \$500 damage to the bumper. The ATV sustained about \$800 damage. The driver of the Toyota was not injured. The investigation is continuing.

Any charges reported in this press release are merely accusations and the defendants are presumed innocent unless and until proven guilty.
