Subject: Single Vehicle Injury Accident

Summary:

On February 17, 2008 at approximately 2034 hours, Juneau Police and Capital City Fire and Rescue responded to a single motor vehicle accident inbound Egan Drive at the Glacier Highway access. Upon arrival, officers found a 1997 white Ford Explorer overturned on its passenger side facing outbound Egan.

Investigation revealed the single occupant and driver, a 23 year old Sitka resident, was driving inbound on Egan Drive and lost control of the vehicle. The vehicle impacted the guardrail and then overturned coming to rest on the passenger side. The vehicle was totaled and an unspecified amount of damage was sustained to the guardrail.

CCFR personnel removed the driver from the vehicle and transported her to Bartlett Regional Hospital for treatment of minor injuries.

Alcohol may have been a factor in the cause of the accident. However, the accident is still under investigation. The driver was initially cited for Basic Speed and Failure to Carry Proof of Insurance.

Any charges reported in this press release are merely accusations and the defendants are presumed innocent unless and until proven guilty.
