Subject: Theft 1st degree

Summary:

On Saturday 04-12-2008, around 11:15am, a Mendenhall Valley resident called the Juneau Police Department to report the theft of a large sum of money from a safe in her home.

The victim told officers the last time the money was known to be intact was approximately two weeks ago. She said she counted the money today (04-12-2008) and discovered that \$26,000 in cash was missing. The victim named 3 or 4 possible suspects and the investigation is continuing.

Should charges be brought in this case the person(s) responsible will likely be charged with Burglary and Theft in the 1st Degree, both "B" Felonies.

Any charges reported in this press release are merely accusations and the defendants are presumed innocent unless and until proven guilty.
