Subject: Burglary

Summary:

On 06-30-2008 at 3:15am the Juneau Police Department received a report that an Auke Bay business had possibly been burglarized.

Responding officers discovered the front door to the business had been shattered and entry had been gained. Officers searched the area and found a man hiding in a ditch nearby. He had fresh cuts on his hands and attempted to flee from officers. A Taser was deployed to gain control of the man and detain him. He was found to be in possession of numerous unopened packs of cigarettes both on his person and in a black plastic bag in his possession. These items are believed to have been stolen in the burglary.

The man was taken to Bartlett Regional Hospital for a medical evaluation, and then transported to the Juneau Police Department for additional questioning.

The man, 28 year old Juneau resident Joel Mundy, was subsequently charged with Burglary in the 2nd degree a class C felony and theft in the 4th degree, a misdemeanor. He was lodged at Lemon Creek Correctional Center without bail.

Any charges reported in this press release are merely accusations and the defendants are presumed innocent unless and until proven guilty.
