## INFORMATION RELEASE

### Summary:

**On 08-30-08 at about 3:00 a.m., the Juneau Police Dept. responded to a report of a vehicle on its side in the 300 block of 6<sup>th</sup> St. in Juneau. It was further reported that there was a passenger trapped inside.**

**On arrival, officers located a 1992 Jeep Cherokee resting on the passenger side over an approximate two foot sidewalk embankment. The Jeep was resting on its side against a residential building. A 29 year old female was lodged in the Jeep with her hand trapped under the Jeep. Officers and bystanders rolled the Jeep up enough to relieve pressure so the female could be freed.**

**Capital City Fire Rescue responded and administered aid to the female who was ultimately transported to Bartlett Regional Hospital for treatment of her injury.**

**The driver, 33 year old John Maddox, was ultimately placed under arrest for Driving While Intoxicated and Reckless Endangerment and lodged at the Lemon Creek Correctional Facility. Both offenses are class A Misdemeanors.**

**Any charges reported in this press release are merely accusations and the defendants are presumed innocent unless and until proven guilty.**
