See previous release for initial information.

On 10/29/2008, at approximately 2:17 pm, the Juneau Police Department was notified by the Alaska State Troopers that a body had been located under the water. The body was located in the Gastineau Channel near the downtown docks. In essence, a private diver had located the body. Specific questions about the Search and Recovery efforts should be referred to the Alaska State Troopers.

The body was taken ashore and positively identified as 38 year old Juneau Resident Arthur TEEL. Next of kin has been notified. Other than being submerged in water for two days, there were no external signs of trauma to TEEL.

The Alaska State Medical Examiner's office was notified of the incident.
