Summary:

On 05/18/2009, at approximately 9:27 am, the Juneau Police Department received a report of a residential burglary located on the 11,000 block of the North Douglas Highway. In essence, a homeowner reported that an unidentified male had entered the residence after forcing open the door. The homeowner was present when the incident occurred and confronted the male. The male said that he was there to do landscaping work and must have gone to the wrong address. The male left in a mid sized black pickup and the homeowner called the police.

On 05/18/2009, at approximately 9:34 hours, Juneau Police officers stopped a mid sized black pickup near the 5800 block of the North Douglas Highway. The driver and sole occupant of the truck told officers that he was at the residence near 11,000 North Douglas to do landscaping work. The homeowner arrived and identified the male as the person they confronted inside the residence.

The male provided a false name to the officers. The male was later identified as 22 year old Juneau resident Corey MURPHY. The truck was seized and MURPHY was taken to JPD. It was determined that MURPHY had an outstanding Felony No Bail arrest warrant for a Parole Violation. MURPHY was then transported to the Lemon Creek Correctional Center and lodged on the No Bail Warrant.

MURPHY is considered a person of interest and the investigation is continuing. Any individuals with information concerning MURPHY, or any burglaries, are encouraged to contact the Juneau Police Department.

Any charges reported in this press release are merely accusations and the defendants are presumed innocent unless and until proven guilty.
