Summary:

On Saturday May 30, 2009, about 23:35 pm, the Juneau Police Department received a report of an assault in progress in the area of Blue Jay Street and Whitehead Street in Switzer Village Trailer Court. Responding officers found a 26-year-old Juneau male, a 27-year-old Juneau male, and a 27-year-old Angoon female on Whitehead Street in Switzer Village Trailer Court. The 26-year-old male was bleeding from multiple wounds to the head and shoulders. The 27-year-old male was bleeding from the left side of his head and the female was tending to the injured males.

Investigation revealed two other Juneau residents, a 25-year-old male, and a 21-year-old male were additionally involved in the fight with the two previously mentioned males. The 21-year-old male was stabbed under his left arm once in the upper torso and once in the lower abdomen. The 25-year-old male was stabbed in the upper torso under his left arm and had a defensive stab wound to his right wrist. The stab wounds were sustained during the fight.

All participants were treated for their injuries at Bartlett Regional Hospital.

Subsequently, 27-year-old Juneau resident Terry Stansell was arrested for disorderly conduct. He was transported to the Lemon Creek Correctional Center where he was held on \$750.00 bail. 26-year-old Juneau resident Johnathan Jackson was arrested for Assault 2nd degree a class B Felony. He was transported to the Lemon Creek Correctional Center where he was lodged without bail.

Alcohol was a factor. This investigation is ongoing and further charges are pending.
