50th Anniversary of Statehood Flag Raising

Juneau 4TH of July Parade

The Juneau 4th of July parade will begin at 12:00 noon at the Department of Labor building on West 8th Street. The parade route is as follows:

The parade will begin at Egan Drive and West 8th Street. It will travel inbound on Egan Drive via the outbound lanes to Main Street. It will turn left and travel up Main Street. The parade will turn right onto Front Street and continue on Front Street traveling against the normal flow of traffic. It will turn right onto Franklin Street and travel against the normal flow of traffic to the traffic circle. The parade will then head outbound on Egan Drive via the inbound lanes to West 8th.

The Juneau Police Department will be closing all of the above-referenced streets to vehicular traffic starting at approximately 11:30 AM. All listed streets will be posted "No Parking".

Any vehicles parked on the parade route, or on Calhoun Avenue near the City Museum, will be impounded at the owner's expense, and vehicles will be unavailable for pick up until Monday, July 6th. The Juneau Police Department will begin impounding vehicles at 9:30 A.M. on the morning of July 4th.

Due to the large volume of July 4th foot traffic, the streets surrounding the parade route become very congested. For the safety of those participating and watching the parade, all traffic will be held until the parade is complete and has passed the 10th Street and Egan Drive intersection. All streets and parking lots within the parade route boundary will also be closed to vehicular traffic during this time.
