Subject: Misconduct Involving Weapons Date: 9/11/2009

**Summary:** 

On 9/11/2009 at 8:05am, the Juneau Police Department received a report of a man with a rifle in the Twin Lakes area, pointing the rifle towards Egan Drive.

Responding officers located 25 year old Washington resident, Julian Hendricks.

Hendricks appeared to have a rifle protruding from his backpack.

Officers attempted to question him about the incident and Hendricks just stared at them.

For officer safety purposes, Hendricks was detained in handcuffs, at which time a large 12-inch knife fell out from underneath his shirt where it was concealed.

A 6-inch knife, in a sheath, was also located on a homemade necklace underneath Hendricks' shirt, where it was concealed.

The rifle inside Hendricks' backpack was determined to be a 760 Pumpmaster BB gun, with scope.

Hendricks was subsequently placed under arrest for Misconduct Involving Weapons in the Fifth Degree for failing to immediately inform officers of the concealed knives.

Hendricks was transported to the Lemon Creek Correctional Center, where he was lodged on \$500 bail.

The investigation continues.
