## INFORMATION RELEASE

**Subject: MVC/Injury Egan Drive near Twin Lakes      Date: 9/19/2009**

### **Summary:**

**On 9/19/2009 at 12:41pm, the Juneau Police Department received multiple reports of a two-vehicle accident on Egan Drive, near Twin Lakes.**

**Juneau Police Department officers and Capital City Fire and Rescue personnel responded to scene.**

**Investigation revealed a 1999 Ford pickup truck, driven by a 54 year old man, was driving on Egan Drive at an estimated 15mph. The Ford truck was in the far right lane and had its hazard lights were flashing. A 2000 Mazda pickup truck, driven by a 21 year old female, was also driving in the far right lane at the posted speed limit.**

**The 21 year old female driver did not see the slower moving Ford pickup until it was too late to avoid a collision.**

**The 54 year old male driver of the Ford truck was transported to Bartlett Regional Hospital, by Capital City Fire and Rescue personnel, to be evaluated for injuries.**

**The 21 year old female driver was cited for Driver to Exercise Due Care and Failure to Carry Proof of Insurance.**
