Summary:

On 11/01/2009, at 1834 hours, the Juneau Police Department received numerous calls about a motor vehicle collision on Egan Dr near Twin Lakes. Follow up callers reported there were injuries. JPD officers and personnel from Capital City Fire and Rescue responded.

Upon arrival, it was determined that a 1991 Dodge Shadow had been proceeding outbound on Egan approaching the Vanderbilt intersection. A 2007 Nissan Sentra rear-ended the Dodge, causing the Dodge's trunk to compact and render the front doors in-operable. The 21-year-old male driver of the Dodge and his 25-year-old female passenger were extricated by CCF/R personnel. Both Egan Drive fast lanes were closed for about one hour.

The 36-year-old female driver of the Nissan told officers her car had slid on the roadway causing her to rear end the Dodge. There was a 24-year-old female passenger in the Nissan.

The occupants of both vehicles were all first treated by CCF/R EMT's, and then subsequently taken to Bartlett Regional Hospital ER for evaluation of their injuries. The extent of the injuries to the occupants is unknown at this time. Both vehicles were towed from the scene.

The preliminary investigation revealed that alcohol may have been a factor in the accident.

Investigation continues.

Any charges reported in this press release are merely accusations and the defendants are presumed innocent unless and until proven guilty.
