Summary:

On 10/17/2009, at approximately 5:37 pm, the Juneau Police Department received a report of a burglary that occurred at a residence located on the 300 block of 6th Avenue. Items stolen during the burglary included a digital camera, spotting scope, wrist watch, DVD recorder, Ipod, and digital camcorder. The stolen items were estimated to cost approximately \$4,000.

On 10/26/2009, at approximately 8:05 pm, the Juneau Police Department received a report of a burglary that occurred at a residence located on the 9200 block of Gee Street. Items stolen during the burglary included a laptop computer and a Sony Playstation 3. The stolen items were estimated to cost approximately \$800.

On 11/13/2009, at approximately 2:00 pm, JPD investigators contact 26 year old Juneau resident Daniel PETERSEN at a residence located on the 800 block of Calhoun Avenue. Investigators had established that PETERSEN had pawned several stolen items at a local pawn shop. The items pawned included property stolen from both previous burglaries. The total value of the items recovered was approximately \$1,200.

PETERSEN was placed under arrest for Theft in the Second Degree, a Class C Felony, for possessing stolen property. PETERSEN was transported to and lodged at the Lemon Creek Correctional Center and held on no bail.

The investigation continues.

Any charges reported in this press release are merely accusations and the defendants are presumed innocent unless and until proven guilty.
