Summary:

On 11/18/2009, the Juneau Police Department was contacted by the United States Postal Inspection Service. In essence, postal inspectors had intercepted a package destined for Juneau that contained 499 methadone pills. The controlled substances were removed and fake pills were placed into the package.

On 11/20/2009, United States Postal Inspectors and Juneau Police Investigators allowed the package to be received by 38 year old Juneau resident Jonathan J. STEIN. Investigators contacted STEIN and 37 year old Juneau resident Sherrilyn N. MORROW inside their residence. STEIN was in the process of trying to flush the fake pills down the toilet.

STEIN and MORROW were transported to the Juneau Police Department. They were both placed under arrest for Misconduct Involving a Controlled Substance in the 2nd Degree and Misconduct Involving a Controlled Substance in the 4th Degree. STEIN and MORROW were transported to and lodged at the Lemon Creek Correctional Center and held on no bail.

The investigation continues.

Any charges reported in this press release are merely accusations and the defendants are presumed innocent unless and until proven guilty.
