Subject: Vehicle Rollover Date: 11-22-09

Summary:

On 11-22-09 at about 1:30 p.m., JPD responded to a reported vehicle rollover at Glacier Hwy near Central Ave.

Investigation revealed a 2003 Saturn SUV was traveling Glacier Hwy outbound. It lost control on the icy road and slid into the oncoming lane colliding with a 2007 Mazda passenger car that was driving Glacier Hwy inbound. The Mazda had two occupants who were un-injured. The Saturn continued to slide on the roadway and went over an approximate 7 foot embankment coming to rest on its top in the ditch.

Capitol City Fire Rescue responded and extricated the driver of the Saturn, a 45 year old female. She was taken to Bartlett Regional Hospital for precautionary evaluation. Glacier Hwy was closed to through traffic for about 30 minutes.

This investigation is ongoing.
