Summary:

On 12/13/2009, at approximately 8:56 am, the Juneau Police Department received a report of a burglary to a business located on the 9100 block of the Glacier Highway. In essence, the business had been entered and a safe was stolen. The investigation revealed that two people had preformed the burglary and theft. The suspects were identified as 28 year old male Juneau resident Michael D. MORRIS, and 20 year old female Juneau resident Angela R. JOHNSON. Both MORRIS and JOHNSON were ex-employees of the business.

On 12/13/2009, at approximately 12:24 pm, a vehicle being driven by MORRIS was stopped by Juneau police on Vanderbilt Road. MORRIS was placed under arrest for Burglary in the Second Degree a Class C Felony, Theft in the Second Degree a Class C Felony, and Criminal Mischief in the Third Degree a Class C Felony. MORRIS was transported to and lodged at the Lemon Creek Correctional Center and held on No Bail.

On 12/13/2009, at approximately 1:07 pm, JOHNSON was contacted at her residence located in the Mendenhall Valley. JOHNSON was placed under arrest for Burglary in the Second Degree a Class C Felony, Theft in the Second Degree a Class C Felony, and Criminal Mischief in the Third Degree a Class C Felony. MORRIS was transported to and lodged at the Lemon Creek Correctional Center and held on No Bail.

JPD officers obtained a search warrant for MORRIS and JOHNSON's residence. The safe from the burglary was located in the residence and seized as evidence.

Investigation Continues.

Any charges reported in this press release are merely accusations and the defendants are presumed innocent unless and until proven guilty.
