Subject: Motor Vehicle Roll Over

Summary:

On 02-20-10 about 08:23 a.m., JPD received a report of a single vehicle roll over at Egan Drive inbound just past Fred Meyer. JPD Officers and Capitol City Fire Rescue (CCFR) responded.

Investigation revealed a 2001 Ford F-150 pickup driven by an 18-year-old female Juneau resident was Egan inbound approaching the area of Fred Meyer. The vehicle was reported to be travelling approximately 60 mph. The weather was about 26 degrees, foggy, with icy road conditions. The driver stated she began to slide as she was changing lanes and lost control of the vehicle. The vehicle went into the median, rolled several times, and came to rest in the upright position.

The passenger a 21-year-old male Juneau resident got out of the vehicle on his own. The driver was pinned in the vehicle and had to be extricated by CCFR. Both the driver and passenger were transported to Bartlett Regional Hospital for treatment of their apparent non-life threatening injuries.

The inbound left lane of Egan Drive was closed for about 30 minutes while the scene was processed. The truck was totaled and towed from the scene.

Any charges reported in this press release are merely accusations and the defendants are presumed innocent unless and until proven guilty.
