Subject: Death Investigation

Summary:

This morning (March 26, 2010) at 9:15 am, Juneau Police Officers and Capital City Fire/Rescue received a call of a possible deceased person. Upon arrival officers found 42 year old Juneau resident Lenora “June” Reyes lying outside on the porch of the residence and 41 year old Juneau resident Sandra Cook (Ellis) lying on the kitchen floor. Both women were deceased.

Further investigation found various prescription medications and other drug paraphernalia inside the residence. At this point the cause of death for both women is unknown however JPD does not expect foul play. A request for autopsies on both women has been sent to the State Medical Examiner’s office. Next of kin have been notified.

The Juneau Police Department would like to thank the State Medical Examiner’s office, who had personnel in town on other business, for responding to the scene and assisting with the investigation.

The investigation continues in this case.

Any charges reported in this press release are merely accusations and the defendants are presumed innocent unless and until proven guilty.
